



How to make use of the map

The green area on the map indicates the city boundaries. The pink area indicates the T'chum Shabbos boundaries. Only people residing within the city boundaries are permitted to walk the entire city and the surrounding T'chum Shabbos area.

People living within the pink area have the option of placing an Eiruv T'chumin within the green area. By placing the Eiruv within the city they established for themselves the Shvisa of the city, and are therefore permitted to walk the entire city and its T'chum Shabbos area. It has to be stressed, that by placing an Eiruv within the city boundaries, one loses his original T'chum.

Awareness

- 1) People living outside of the city (Out side of the green area) have a different T'chum Shabbos, which is to be individually determined by an expert.
- 2) Arranging an Eiruv T'chumin properly is a complicated task, therefore a competent Rov should be consulted beforehand.

Anyone traveling with the intention to get to the city for Shabbos, as soon as he reached the pink area he established for himself the Shvisa of the city and its T'chum boundaries.
